Equipment:	You will be given blank writing paper for working into the test. The following items are not allowed in the examination room: - Mobile phones, smartwatches, or programmable watches - Calculators - Dictionaries - Notes									
Test details:	- Reading and Numeracy tests are in a multiple-choice question format (actual tests: 45 minutes / Practice test: 15 minutes). - Writing test is a typed response of approximately 500 words in response to a question or picture (maximum 45 minutes for practice and real tests). - You must <u>stay on the test site</u> for the duration of the test session. - it is a breach of test rules to access other sites, use other applications or use a calculator other than the one provided within <u>the test and that such action will be recorded</u>. - If any breach of test rules or malpractice is found to have occurred, including the writing of responses that are considered offensive, your test attempt may be <u>declared invalid</u> and you <u>may not be permitted to re-sit the test for a period of up to 12 months</u>.									
On test day:	- You will be given your PIN letter which contains the test URL, your student number and PIN to log in to the tests. - You must accept the conditions in order to sit the test. - When the supervisor tells you to start, read the instructions and log in using your student number and PIN. - You can then begin the test. The time that you have remaining to complete the test will display at all times on the top right hand corner of the page. - Once you have finished the test, select 'Submit and finish'.									
Results:	- Reading & Numeracy: the test coordinator can view your results immediately after your test. - Writing: results will be available to your test coordinator 20 days after your test. The test coordinator can provide you with a copy of your test report or make them available to you on <i>Students Online</i>.
